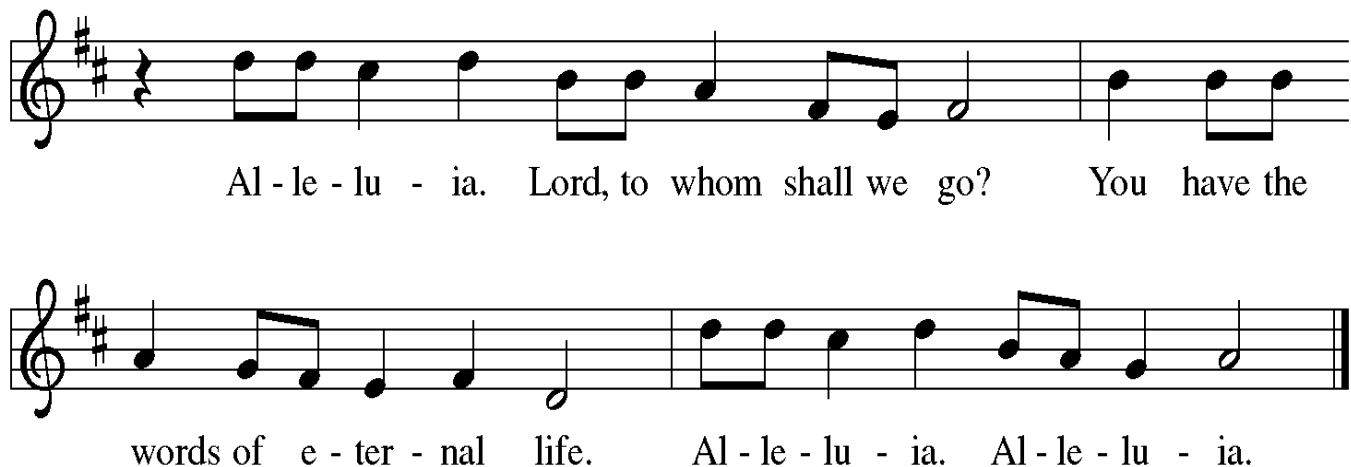

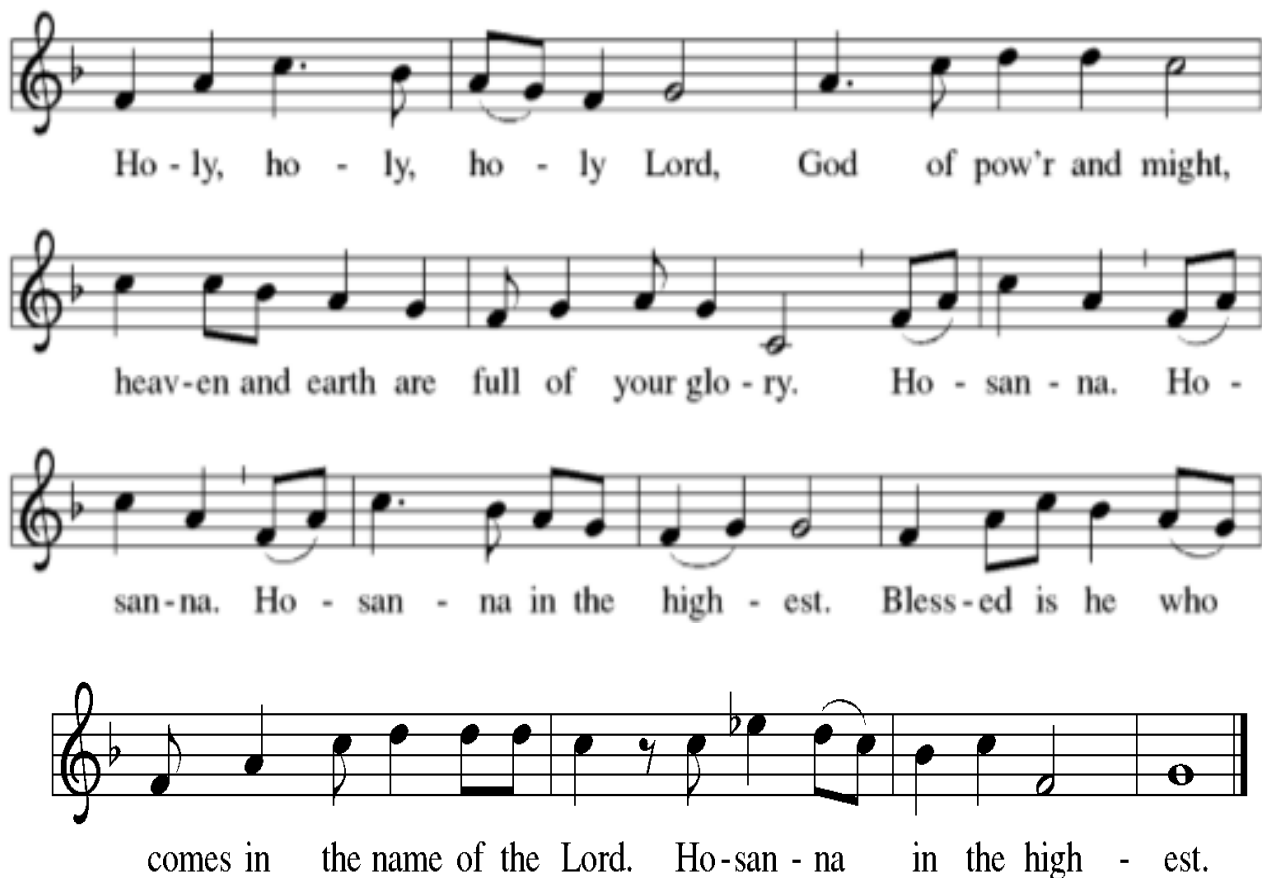

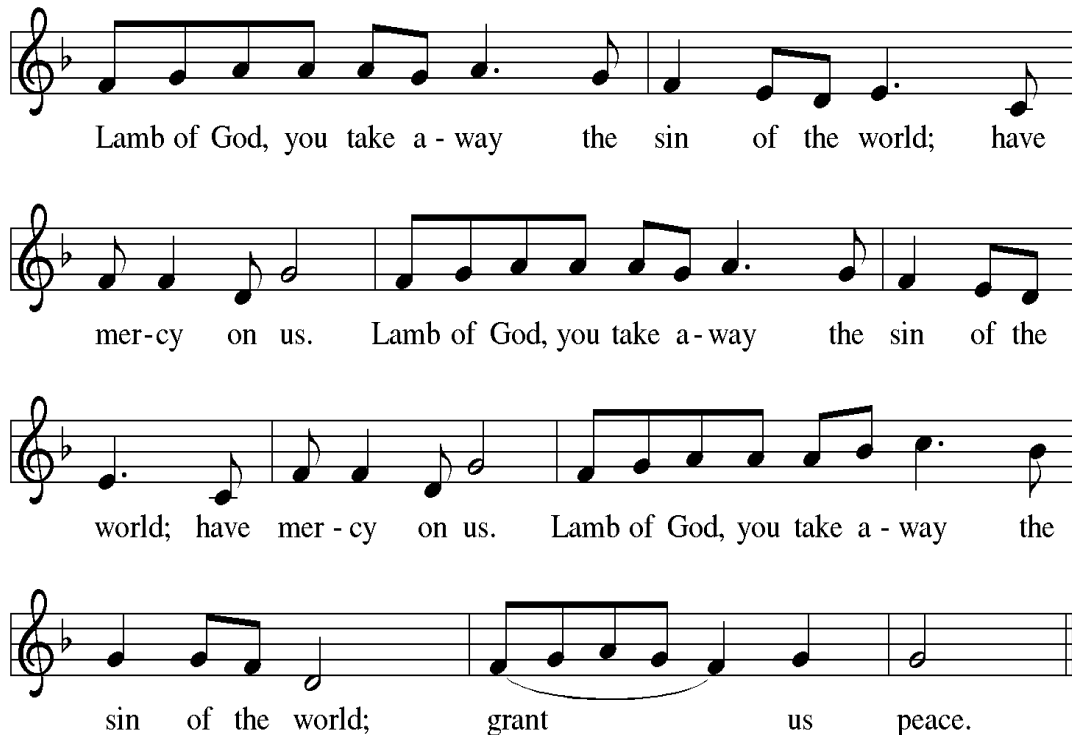
Lord's Prayer
